## History

In the first decades of the 20th century the only skiing in Victoria was at Mt Buffalo. Getting there involved an arduous 24-hour journey from Melbourne.

In 1924, an intrepid group calling themselves the Ski Club of Victoria decided to bring the adventure of skiing much closer to home. At their first meeting, great enthusiasm was shown over a picture of snow-capped Mt Buller. There was even more excitement when, on Sunday 8 June 1924, an expeditionary party from the club set out for the summit. The SCV's first accommodation was Lovick's Hut, a rough timber and corrugated iron cattlemen's shack. As skiing became more popular in 1929, a small chalet was built at Horse Hill.

SCV member, Major Ivor Whittaker, known as 'Ike' had been a keen skier at Mt Buller but lost his life on active service in the Middle East during World WarTwo. His will made provision for the SCV to build a lodge at Mt Buller for the benefit of Victorian skiing.

Ivor's parents and trustees of his estate, Mr and Mrs Robert C Whittaker honoured their son's wishes and in May 1944, provided the SCV with £500 to build a skier's retreat - the Ivor Whittaker Memorial Lodge, known affectionately as the Whitt. Today, the Whitt is home to the SCV and effectively, the home of skiing on Mt Buller.

# Racing Program

Snowsports Racing (Alpine and Snowboard) is one of the main reasons SCV was created and until 1955 the SCV managed all Victorian skiing and ski racing.

Today race days are competitive, but never at the expense of fun. Our races are often a family event and our results are based on an improvement-based handicap system, so that everyone who participates gets the credit they deserve (unless their own children beat them, as often happens, and then there's plenty of friendly banter all round).

SCV Saturday races have helped develop many Australian and Olympic ski and snowboard champions including Marilla, Alistair and Anthony Guss, Rob McIntyre, Judy and Peter Forass, Peter Brockhoff and Anton Grimus. As a club we strive to see our junior racers continue to make the SCV a gateway for winter sports champions.

The SCV created its own sponsorship program to help out up and coming athletes with the financial strain of competing at an international level, athletes such as Jakara Anthony, Jonty O'Callaghan and Jess Haslau have all received financial assistance from the SCV to keep their Winter Olympic dreams alive.

#### Accommodation

The Ski Club of Victoria offers both hotel style accommodation and the traditional lodge experience.

Both SCV lodges - Ivor Whittaker Memorial Lodge (the Whitt) and Kandahar Lodge - enable you to ski straight to Shakey Knees and Bourke Street runs from your front door.

Kandahar Lodge is self-catering with comfortable bunkrooms, shared bathrooms and comes with full ski-in ski-out service.

The Whitt offers en suite bedrooms with inhouse access to Mt Buller's most popular social venues - our highly regarded restaurant and the historic and thoroughly charming Ike's Bar.

All Whitt rooms come equipped with all linen and towels, toiletries, a small bar fridge, tea and coffee making facilities, TV, DVD player and daily servicing.

There are 3 room types; Whitt Standard Room - Sleeps 2-5 Whitt Studio Room with Kitchenette - Sleeps 4 Whitt Studio Apartment - Sleeps 7

The Studio and Standard rooms can be joined to create a 2 bedroom suite that sleeps 9.

Kandahar Rooms come equipped with linen and guests are expected to strip their beds on departure. The lodge offers a fully self catered kitchen with all your daily needs, plenty of dining space, 2 x living areas and an open fireplace.

Both lodges offer a drying room and ski storage for guests.

We encourage you to arrive early and make the most of our luggage storage facilities at each lodge.

Priority members only bookings open in November each year and run through to March.
